

### PROGRAMS OFFERED BY FRIENDS FOR YOUTH:

The One-to-One Community Mentoring Program provides youth with an engaged and supportive relationship with a caring adult mentor. Friends for Youth follows best practices of mentoring through quality volunteer training, matching, close supervision and personalized case management. The commitment is for matches to meet a min. of 2X per month, for a min. of 4 hours per month, for one year.

The Family Advocates & Mentors (FAM) program is funded by the Colorado Department of Human Services, Core Services Program and is designed to provide youth and families with life skills services, youth mentoring, community resources, parenting skills training, advocacy, and a variety of other services. The goal of the FAM program is to keep families together by giving them the tools and support needed to be self-sufficient and positively attached. Services are provided by trained and caring adults from the same communities as the families being served.

Through the Colorado Department of Education we teach young people about Healthy Relationships under the Sexual Risk Avoidance Education umbrella. The Colorado Title V State Sexual Risk Avoidance Education (SRAE) Grant Program is part of a comprehensive approach to adolescent well-being that seeks to support Colorado youth in developing and navigating healthy relationships and in making decisions that result in reduced rates of teen pregnancy and sexually transmitted infections (STIs), including HIV. SRAE programs use a Positive Youth Development (PYD) framework as part of a risk avoidance strategy to help participants develop healthy life skills, increase individual protective factors that reduce risks, make healthy decisions, engage in healthy relationships, and set goals that lead to self-sufficiency and marriage before engaging in sexual activity. SRAE programs teach youth personal responsibility, self-regulation, goal setting, healthy decision-making, a focus on the future, and the prevention of youth risk behaviors such as drug and alcohol use without normalizing teen sexual activity.



All Friends for Youth Board of Director Members serve for a three-year term.
